

Grand Prix Casper WY AAU Tournament Information

- At the Ford Wyoming Center all players and coaches will enter through the east end entrance of the building and all parents will enter through the main doors. Parents are welcome to drop their players off then go park.
- There is a \$5.00 entrance fee for anyone 6 and up only at the Ford Wyoming Center
- Ford Wyoming Center will have concessions, no outside food is allowed.
- At the Rec Center and YMCA you may bring snacks/coolers and you will need to bring chairs.
- **At the YMCA since we are running 6 team pools please limit your spectators to two per player (Saturday only)**

- **Pool Play** schedule will be as follows

- **Saturday:**

- U10's will play at the YMCA starting at 8:00 a.m.
- U12A's will play at the Casper Rec Center at 8:00 a.m.
- U12B's will play at the Ford Wyoming Center at 8:00 a.m.
- U14B's will play at the Ford Wyoming Center at 2:30 p.m. (we will keep everyone up to date if this changes)

- **Sunday:**

- U18's will play at the YMCA or the Casper Rec Center at 8:00 a.m.
- U14A's will play at the Ford Wyoming Center at 7:00 a.m.
- U16's will play at the Ford Wyoming Center at 2:30 (we will keep everyone posted if this changes)

- Do not allow your players, parents, or fans to walk behind players while serving.
- Do not allow your players to use balls in the hallways.
- Please clean up your team's area before you leave.
- Medals will be given for 1st and 2nd place teams
